28th May Uranus comes into Aries (4.44 European time, 27th May 10:44 PM New York Time)

The sign change by this planet is one that strongly changes everything that happens over the whole world. On average Uranus changes sign every seven years and is the bringer of renewal and market explosions occur in other areas. This time Uranus leaves the last sign of the zodiac, Pisces, and enters the first sign Aries. With Uranus in Aries the world has seen many of mankind's meaningful inventions but also people's justice and wars: The wrist watch, the microscope, Spanish inquisition in the **16th century**, fire extinguisher in the 17th century and the Chinese claim on Taiwan.

In the 18th century: the pencil, the chronometer and the roller-skates were invented.

Biological warfare in the French and Indian wars; tax revolts started in the British colonies.

In the 19th century: a gold rush took place in California (Wikipedia: “The most famous gold rush took place in [California](#). The gold that was found in [1848](#) at [Sutter's Mill](#) created a rush of more than 40.000 migrants all wanting to try their luck. The gold diggers were jointly responsible for the economic growth in this area.”

Inventions of note were the sewing machine, the typewriter, the safety pin, refined sugar, sweet chocolate and the ice making machine. The Chicago Board of Trade opened. Rail roads were criss-crossing the states east of the Mississippi. The electric telegraph was invented by Prof. Morse. And above that Neptune was discovered, seen by telescope in 1846 in Berlin.





The last passage of Uranus in Aries was from **31st March 1927 - 6th June 1934**. During this period the U.S. shares market saw the highest peak and the greatest fall as has never been seen since. Firstly whipped up to higher highs, “the sky is the limit”, as cars (Ford model A) rolled from the conveyor belts and roads were being built. The telephone was invented and the first films with sound appeared. It didn't seem to stop: the electric microscope was invented – but the Nazi's, who had been living since 1919 in crisis in Germany, won in popularity and market sentiment changed after “Black Monday”, the NYSE peak and deep fall from 1929-1932. “STEEL PRICES SET TO SOAR

According to the headlines in the 3/31/10 issue of the *Financial Times*, global steel prices are set to leap up to a third, pushing up the cost of everyday goods from cars to domestic appliances, after miners and steel makers agreed to a ground-breaking change in the iron ore price system. The top ore miners stand to profit in the short term from the new price system. One executive estimated that the profits of the big three producers, **Vale (VALE), Rio Tinto (RTP) and BHP Billiton (BHP)**, would be boosted by at least \$5 billion this year. This fits the pattern forming this summer as Jupiter moves into Aries on June 6. Steel prices as well as most Basic Materials should do well.”
